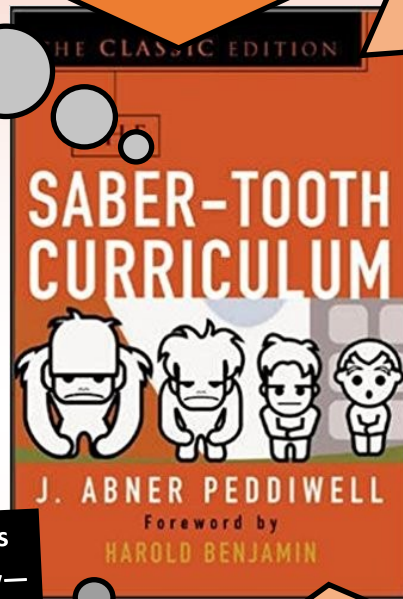
21st Century Schools

A, B, C of Curriculum Design

How to Engage Learning

- Creating questions of their own
- Problem solve and obtain supporting evidence to answer the questions
- Explain the evidence collect
- Connecting the explanation to knowledge obtained
- Create an argument and justification for findings (understand other opinions of bias)
